## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 22 1/2 x 82 in. (57 x 208.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball® (Art. #828)
  - 302 Prism 1 ball (A)
  - 304 Lotus Blossom 2 balls (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

1 ripple = about 3 3/4 in. (9.5 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **NOTES**

1. Shawl is worked in one piece in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. The ripple is created by skipping 2 sts to form valleys and working 3 dc to form peaks. In each row, take care to skip the 2 sts in each valley and work 3 dc in the center dc of each 3-dc peak of the previous row.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
4. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

### **SHAWL**

With A, ch 78.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), dc in next 3 ch, \*3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 5 ch; rep from \* to last 6 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in last 5 ch. you will have 6 ripples. **Note:** The ripple pattern may not be clear until you have worked several rows.

**Row 2:** Turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 dc, \*3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from \* to last 6 dc and beg ch-3, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc, leave beg ch-3 unworked.

**Rows 3-24:** Rep Row 2 for 22 more times. Change to B in last st of Row 24.

With B, rep Row 2 until there is not enough B remaining to work another full row.

Change to A in last st of last row.

With A, rep Row 2 for 24 times.

Fasten off.

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## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
